**Bienville Monument Museum** Lauderdale Street and Water Avenue, Selma, AL 36701 (GPS Coordinates: N32.403869, W-87.026789)

The first time Selma appeared on a map in the early 1700's, it was known as Ecor Bienville and named after John Baptiste Le Moyne Sieur De Bienville, a French explorer and colonial governor of Louisiana. The monument, erected in 1932 by the National Society of Colonial Dames of America, was placed to commemorate the engagement between Bienville and the Alibamo Indians on the bluff along the Alabama River.

This baseball stadium has been home to both collegiate and professional baseball teams, although it is currently used for high school and American Legion baseball. Park features a playground, walking trail and is also home to the Farmer's Market.

**Bridgetender's House** Selma, AL 36703

This small cottage sits on the edge of a bluff above the Alabama River next to the St. James Hotel. Selma's first bridge across the Alabama River was opened in 1885 allowing river traffic to pass. Opening and closing this span and collecting tolls was a 24-7 job performed by a bridge tender. The old bridge was destroyed but its cornerstone can still be seen from the cottage's downstairs porch.

Headquarters for meetings during the Civil Rights movement in Selma. Brown Chapel was organized by freed men after the Civil War and is noted for its exterior Byzantine design. A monument to Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was dedicated in front of Brown Chapel in 1979.

The Dallas County Courthouse was originally a Neo-Classic building built in 1910. In 1965, protesters from Brown Chapel AME Church marched down Alabama Avenue to the courthouse in an effort to register to vote.

Dallas County Public Lake is a compact site housing a good variety of habits around a 100-acre lake-emergent lakeside edge, both second-growth and mature woodland and open pine-oak woods.

**Edmund Pettus Bridge** (GPS Coordinates N 32.40646 and W 87.0178)

*Located at the intersection of Broad St. and Water Ave. in downtown Selma.*

The Edmund Pettus Bridge spans over the Alabama River in downtown Selma, AL. It is a steel through-arch bridge that was designed by Henson K. Stephenson and erected in 1940. The Edmund Pettus Bridge was the site of the historic civil rights conflicts known as the Selma to Montgomery Marches and "Bloody Sunday." The demonstrations that occurred here led to the U.S. Voting Rights Act of 1965. The Edmund Pettus Bridge is a symbol of the civil rights movement.

Constructed in 1894 in the Gothic Revival style by a local black architect, Dave Benjamin West, is considered one of the most architecturally significant late-19<sup>th</sup>-century black churches in the state. It played a pivotal role in the Selma marches that helped lead to the passage of the 1965 Voting Rights Act.

Continuously owned by the Kenan family until Elizabeth Kenan Buchanan donated it to the Selma Dallas County Historic Preservation Society in 1997, restoration is on-going with the mill fully operational. Open during special events only.

A tour of the museum runs the gamut from Civil War to Civil Rights, from William Rufus King, the Vice President who was one of Selma's founders in 1819, to Martin Luther King, a Nobel Peace Prize winner who led voting rights demonstrations here in 1965.

Paul M Grist State Park is a tranquil 1,080-acre park that includes a beautiful 100-acre lake that is surrounded by hardwood and southern pine woodlands. Visitors can rent a canoe or small boat for fishing or exploring. The park also has several miles of hiking trails winding through the forest that surrounds the lake.
